How do you fight mission-killing fears?

1. Remember Jesus is already installed as King over the nations. (Luke 20:42-43)

2. Remember the Kingdom you have entered is unshakeable. (Hebrews 12:22-24)

3. Remember He shakes the earth to shake us awake. (Hebrews 12:25-27)

4. Rejoice with Trembling. You are safe in Jesus. (Hebrews 12:28)

2. Decide to stand up for Christ no matter how challenging the situation.
